This notice pertains to the scoring of Part B-2, questions 54 and 55 of the Spanish edition only of the Regents Examination in Physical Setting /Earth Science.

A Data Table accompanies questions 54 through 56. In the Spanish edition this Table lists “*pizarra*,” the Spanish word for “slate,” in the first box under “*Nombre de la roca*,” “Rock Name.” It should list “*arcillosa*,” the Spanish word for “shale.” Students who used the Spanish edition, either exclusively or in conjunction with the English edition, should be given credit for questions 54 and 55.
